

Venue	<p>Bluebell Barn Farm, Copt Hall Road, Cobham, Gravesend, Kent, DA13 9AU ///spike.scared.zooms</p> <p>We shoot on a field on a working farm that is also our hosts' home. Please drive carefully on the local roads and be respectful of neighbours. Be mindful of farm equipment and trip hazards and look out for animals when moving around the premises.</p>
Arrows	All arrows must be collected by the end of the shoot and must not be left on the premises.
Refreshments	Refreshments will be available throughout the day.
Tents	Due to limited space behind the shooting line, tents will not be allowed on site however we will provide shelter (gazebos) behind the line for archers.
Accessibility	As this is a working farm the ground can be slightly uneven, and our shooting line is up to 300 metres away from the parking area. Those with limited mobility should contact the tournament organiser in advance to organise parking options.
Rounds/ Faces	<p>WA 70m round for recurve and longbow; shot on a 122cm full face WA 50m round for all barebow; shot on a 122cm full face. WA 50m round for all compounds; shot on individual 6 zone 80cm face</p> <p>Entries for rounds matching appropriate bow type will be given priority due to limited space, other entries will be added to the waiting list and released closer to the date if space is available.</p>
Timings	<p>Field Open From - 07:45am Equipment Inspection - 08:15am Assembly - 08:45am Practice: 09.00am – 09.30am 4 archers shooting in two details in ends of six arrows in 4 minutes.</p>
Bosses	Where possible, all bow types will shoot on foam bosses, except for longbow which will be shot on straw bosses.

Entry	<p>Online entries via</p> <p>https://forms.gle/mxxYqNjDPdUKkPpu7</p> <p>Closing date: Sunday 2nd August 2026 or when full, we will operate a waiting list once full.</p> <p>Tournaments are open to any archer currently affiliated to Archery GB or World Archery. Proof of membership will be required.</p> <p>Dress Regulations as shown in AGB Rule 307 will apply.</p>
Fees & Cancellations	<p>£20.00 Senior and Junior</p> <p>Entry fees will not be reimbursed after the closing date.</p>
Awards	<p>1st, 2nd and 3rd place awards will be allocated in each category.</p> <p>Award allocation will be based on scores for each category and will be presented at the end of the shoot.</p>
Target List	<p>A target list will be available on Bowmen of Darenteford's website as soon as reasonably possible after the closing date and emailed to all confirmed entrants.</p>

Liability	<p>None of Bowmen of Darenteford's Archers, Judges, or affiliated parties can accept responsibility for any loss, damage or injury however caused.</p> <p>Entry to the tournament will be taken as acceptance of these conditions.</p>
Photos	<p>In accordance with the AGB policy for "safeguarding and protecting children and young people", anyone wishing to use photographic/video equipment at a tournament must register prior to the start of the shoot. This includes mobile phone cameras.</p>
Data Protection	<p>By entering Bowmen of Darenteford's competitions, you agree that the information you provide may be shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems, Archery GB and other competitors. Some information may also be published in documents relating to the event. This information includes your name, bow style, round, club, county, region. A target list will be published prior to the event, available on Bowmen of Darenteford's website. Results will be published as soon as possible after the tournament, on Bowmen of Darenteford's website.</p>

AGB Rules	<p>By entering our competitions, you are agreeing to abide by AGB Rules of shooting and the regulations of these tournaments.</p> <p>A parent / guardian must sign on behalf of Juniors. For juniors under 18 years of age, the tournament organiser must be notified of the senior person who will be taking due care and responsibility for that junior the whole time they are on Bowmen of Darentford's premises.</p>
Drug Testing	<p>Record status shoots are liable for drug testing. Any competitor approached to give samples for testing must comply. Refusal will be treated as a positive result. Parents / guardians must sign the relevant forms available at the registration desk giving consent for junior archers to be tested if approached.</p>
